Silent Auction Rules and Regulations 2016 ***Please read the following auction rules carefully***

Silent Auction Bidding

The Silent Auction is open for bids now and will conclude at 3pm on Sunday, 21st August (the day of the Fete). Pre-fete bids will be taken via SMS to 0414730842 or email attractions@greatfete.com.au. To register your bid please enter your name, phone, email, Lot # item and bid amount. SMS and Email bidding will close at 12pm on Saturday 20th August (the day before the Fete), any bids received after this time will not be registered. All bids received prior to the fete will be sent a confirmation. If no confirmation is received, your bid may not be registered. Bidding can also be done on the day of the Great Fete at the Silent Auction Stall by writing your bid amounts on the sheets. Bidding via the sheets will continue to the close of the auction.

The Silent Auction table will be open for bidding at 10.00am on Sunday 21st August and will close at 3.00pm promptly on Sunday 21st August. The clock outside the Silent Auction stall will be the only timepiece used to open & close the Auction.

Each item in the Samuel Gilbert Public School P&C Association Silent Auction has a bid sheet. To place a bid write your name, daytime telephone number and the amount of your bid on the bid sheet.

Each new bid must be written on the next available line on the bid sheet. If the end of a sheet has been reached please use the clear bid sheet underneath.

All Silent Auction items remain the property of Samuel Gilbert Public School P&C Association until funds are paid in full and cleared.

Some Silent Auction items have a reserve price. These items will not be sold until the reserve price is met.

All bids must be in increments of \$5.00 (AU). Silent Auction bids may be disqualified if the minimum amount raised is not sufficient.

The end of the Auction will be announced by the MC 5 minutes before closing. At 3pm ONLY an authorised Silent Auction representative can close the Auction and circle the winning bids. Authorised representatives are Fete Coordinators or Silent Auction Coordinator.

Items (including gift certificates) may not be redeemed for cash nor may the expiration dates be extended. Please note that goods, services and travel packages may have various expiration dates as specified by the donor and are subject to availability. No extensions, exchanges or refunds will be made.

All sales are final. Samuel Gilbert Public School P&C Association accept cash, MasterCard, or Visa.

Claiming Silent Auction items

Once an item is paid for and is in your possession it is no longer the responsibility of Samuel Gilbert Public School P&C Association if it is lost, stolen or broken.

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In the event that the winning bidder does not pick up the item at the end of the auction, it is their responsibility to arrange pick up of the item, or to arrange and pay for shipping costs with payment due in advance.

All Silent Auction items will be held for 7 days. If we are unable to contact the winning bidder within this timeframe then the winning bidder forfeits their right to that item and the next highest bidder will be contacted.

Dispute Resolution

In the event of a dispute a Samuel Gilbert Public School P&C Association representative shall have the sole and final discretion to determine the successful bidder or to resell the item in a dispute.
